**Vilmos Németh** (National Innovation Office – NIH, Hungary) received his M. Sc. degree in physics at the Eötvös Loránd University in 1984. Then he worked in the Research Institute for Microelectronics, Central Research Institute for Physics of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (KFKI) in the field of physics and technology of semiconductor devices. In 1992 he started to work for Research and Development Center of Ericsson Hungary Ltd in Budapest. At the same time he was assigned to the director of the Inter-University Centre for Telecommunications and Informatics at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics, Budapest. Here, he managed industry-oriented R&D projects in

infocommunications and university-industry cooperations.

From 2009 till 2011 he led the Programme Planning Department of the NIH. During the Hungarian EU Presidency in the first half of 2011 he coordinated the events the Future Internet Week in Budapest. He initiated the establishment of the Future Internet National Technology Platform and the Hungarian IPv6 Forum, and also contributed to the launch of the national Future Internet (FI) research programmes. He is founding member of the EU's Future Internet Forum (FIF) representing Hungary. At present he is a counsellor of the National Innovation Office and is responsible for FI affairs, and he is also an advocate of the open innovation (Living Labs) in Hungary.
